Evolution in Workflow Operations and Demands

Since 2012, Sompo Singapore has seen a few major shifts in the brand operations – mergers of three companies enforced growth and further development in Sompo Singapore’s performance and progress.

“We have 300 staff members now, and we’ve gone from 9 to 16 copiers over the last year, almost doubling the number of them to streamline our workflow. Canon uniFLOW solution has provided us with the secure platforms we needed.”


"In comparison to other brands, uniFLOW is the best fit for the requirements we have. So that makes going with Canon looked like a logical choice," Mr. Tan continued.

Addressing The Threat of Cybersecurity

Another benefit Mr. Tan saw with uniFLOW was the added security that came with it. uniFLOW's secure printing allows confidential jobs to be held centrally and are only released when the user authenticates at the device. The user can go to any device in any location with the knowledge that their job will be printed securely.
